OPTION 1 – Nomination of the Driver at Fault

For alleged parking offences, vehicle owners are able to nominate another person as the driver or owner of a vehicle by nomination. Statutory Declarations are not required.

OPTION 2 - Statutory Declaration

If you solemnly and sincerely declare that the expiation was wrongfully issued complete the accompanying statutory declaration stating the reasons.

Or

If the offence is a parking offence and you were not driving at the time of the offence, name the driver and their contact details on the Statutory Declaration.

Or

If you had prior to the time of the offence transferred ownership of the vehicle, please state on the Statutory Declaration the name and address of the new owner.

OPTION 3 - Election to be Prosecuted

If you wish to dispute the allegation that you committed the offence and elect to be prosecuted, you may get a summons. The summons will set out when and where to attend court.

OPTION 4 - Dispute the offence informally

You may dispute the expiation informally by stating your reasons in the space provided.
