Port Augusta City Council is pleased to announce the successful outcome of a tender process for the management of the Ryan Mitchell Swim Centre, with the contract awarded to Belgravia Leisure, a well-established and experienced operator in the management of community swim facilities.

Belgravia Leisure boasts a track record of managing several Council-owned facilities throughout South Australia, including Port Pirie Regional Council, and brings a wealth of expertise to the Ryan Mitchell Swim Centre.

The contract, which has been awarded for a period of three years, ensures continuity of service without any additional costs to the community or ratepayers. Council will retain the current pricing structure for entry fees.

The transition process to Belgravia Leisure's management is expected to be completed comprehensively over the next six weeks. This will include the recruitment of additional staff members as needed, with opportunities for existing staff to transition to Belgravia Leisure.

"We anticipate a smooth transition process and are aiming for an early November reopening to provide the community with uninterrupted access to this important recreational facility." Mayor Linley Shine stated.
