Verbal Submission

Most Panel meetings are open to members of the public, however members of the public can not speak or give verbal submission in the meeting, unless they were a representor under Category 2 or 3 Public Notification or an applicant of an application being considered at the meeting.

If either a representor or applicant wishes to be heard by the panel they must inform the Council in writing at least 2 business days prior to the meeting.

When and where are meetings held?

Meetings are normally held on the second Tuesday of every month at 5:30pm unless otherwise stipulated by the Community Planner.

The meetings are held at the Civic Centre of the Port Augusta City Council, in the Council Chambers at 4 Mackay Street, Port Augusta.
